

Coca Cola Apprenticeship

The Coca Cola Apprenticeship is a 22 month paid internship for minority students who have an interest in pursuing a career in the history or museum field. This in-depth program is a great opportunity designed to assist in gaining real life skills and practical work experience necessary to qualify for entry level museum positions. Under the guidance of the apprenticeship program manager, the apprentice will develop and implement a two-year plan for the program experience, assist with planning and implementation of assigned projects and programs. The apprentice will also enroll and successfully complete the Museum Certificate Program as well as complete a two month summer externship at a partnering institution. Interested applicants must have a minimum Bachelor's degree in education, history or related field. Must be willing to travel.

The application process is now open for this program.
